### BUCK SHOTS

- Congratulations to Bucks assistant coach Adrian Griffin, who will be inducted into the Seton Hall Athletics Hall of Fame on February 4, 2010. Griffin, the 18<sup>th</sup> leading scorer in Big East basketball history, was named the Big East Basketball Scholar-Athlete of the Year while at Seton Hall. He saw his numbers rise in each of his four seasons including career-bests in points (19.5), rebounds (8.3) and assists (3.1) as a senior.
- The Bucks are closing in on franchise win number 1,750. They're three victories away at 1,747.
- Carlos Delfino connected on the 200<sup>th</sup> three pointer of his career against New York on Saturday and Kurt Thomas' next game will be the 900<sup>th</sup> of his career.
- Ersan Ilyasova's 13 rebounds on Saturday night represent a career-high and tied the team-high this season.
- Each of Milwaukee's games in the month of November will be played in the Central time zone.
- Milwaukee has controlled the paint so far, allowing 28.0 points-in-the-paint through five games, the lowest in the NBA. They've won the battle in the paint each game with an average of 40.8 - 28.0 points (204-140).
- The Bucks have nearly recorded the rebounding hat-trick as they're tops in the league with 47.6 rebounds, tied for first with 33.6 defensive boards and second on the offensive glass with 14.0.
- Milwaukee has forced foes into 19.4 turnovers per game (second in the league) and has converted those miscues into 20.8 points per game, also second in the league. On Saturday the Bucks scored a season-high 27 points off of 17 Knickerbockers turnovers.
- The Bucks have won the battle of the benches in four of their first five games. Their subs are outscoring the opponent 180-122 (36.0-24.4) this season.

#### ALL-TIME SERIES:

Bucks trail 30-45

- The Nuggets are fourth in the league in scoring with an average of 109.3 points per game, led by Carmelo Anthony's 31.4 points (second in the NBA).
- Denver is the only team in the league to be ranked in the top five in field goal percentage (seventh, .478), free throw percentage (fourth, .791) and three-point percentage (seventh, .402). They have converted on 39 of 97 attempts from behind the arc, with Chauncey Billups contributing the most (16-40). Denver has both made and attempted more free throws than any other team in the league, going 200-253 at the line.
- The Bucks and Nuggets have split each of the last two season series. In both 2007-08 and 2008-09 the home team came out on top. Milwaukee sports a 23-14 (.622) record at home against Denver.

### NEWS & NOTES ...

**GETTING DEFENSIVE** – The Bucks are off to the best defensive start in franchise history, allowing a total of 426 points through five games, an average of 85.2 per tilt. Their previous defensive watermark through five games was 436 points allowed (87.2 per game), set by the 1998-99 squad that started 4-1. This season only Milwaukee has yet to allow 100 points. The Bucks are second in the NBA in points allowed per game and are holding the opposition to 41.7 shooting from the field, which is third in the league. On top of all that, the Bucks are forcing 19.4 turnovers each game, which is second in the NBA.

**CENTER OF ATTENTION** – Bucks center Andrew Bogut has been hard to ignore in the last few games. The Aussie is averaging team-highs in points (18.3), rebounds (10.3), blocks (2.0) and is tied for the team-lead in assists (3.3) in the last three games. In addition, the big-man is getting 1.0 steal per game and shooting 57.1 percent from the field (24-42). Bogut has notched double-doubles in two of his last three tilts, missing a third by two rebounds on Saturday night.

### RECENT GAMES:

November 7, 2009 New York

**W, 102-87** – The Bucks scored a season-best 40 points in the first quarter and 66 points in the first half to beat the Knicks and improve to 2-0 at the Bradley Center. Andrew Bogut led all scorers with a season-high 22 points and Ersan Ilyasova grabbed a career-best 13 rebounds. Rookie Jodie Meeks saw his first action at home and did not disappoint, totaling 19 points with a Bucks single-game best five threes, while fellow rookie Brandon Jennings scored 17.

November 6, 2009 @ Minnesota

**W, 87-72** – A 31-14 third quarter propelled the Bucks past the Timberwolves for their first road win of the season. The Bucks' stingy defense had their best outing of the young season, setting season-bests in points allowed (72) and opponents' shooting percentage (.392). Andrew Bogut registered his second consecutive double-double with team-highs in points (17) and rebounds (10).

November 3, 2009 @ Chicago

**L, 81-83** – The Bulls used a 30-12 run in the second half, including 12 straight points in the third quarter, to erase an 18-point Bucks lead and win their eighth consecutive home contest over Milwaukee. Brandon Jennings led the Bucks in scoring for a third straight game with a career-high and game-leading 25 points while Andrew Bogut (16 points, 13 rebounds) and Hakim Warrick (11, 10) both recorded their first double-doubles of the season.

## NEWS & NOTES CONTINUED ...

**ON POINT** – Through five games this year, rookie point guard Brandon Jennings has been on point. The 10<sup>th</sup> overall selection in the 2009 NBA Draft is averaging team-highs in points (18.4) and assists (4.4) to go along with 4.4 rebounds and 1.6 steals per game. Among rookies he's first in points, fourth in rebounds, second in assists, fifth in field goal percentage, seventh in three point percentage, third in free throw percentage, first in steals and second in minutes. The only category he doesn't appear in is blocks.

**SUPER SUB** – Over the last two games Luke Ridnour has been super in a substitute role. The veteran point guard has scored in double-figures in both of those games and averaged 13.0 points in the back-to-back set. Ridnour has connected on 11-21 shots during that stretch (52.4 percent) and has also chipped in with 2.5 assists and 1.5 rebounds.

### ALL-TIME SERIES:

Bucks lead 73-45

- The Bucks have taken two of the last three games against the Warriors in Milwaukee and sport an all-time record of 43-16 (.729) all-time at home against Golden State.
- Golden State has had some high-scoring affairs to open their season, allowing 100-plus points in all six of their games. The Warriors have also scored 100-plus in their first six, ranking second in the NBA with 110.7 points per game. They're 29<sup>th</sup> in points allowed at 113.2 points and 28<sup>th</sup> in defensive field goal percentage (49.9).
- Six Warriors are averaging in double-figures this season: Monta Ellis (18.3), Stephen Jackson (16.3), Kelenna Azubuike (15.5), Anthony Morrow (14.5), Corey Maggette (12.7) and Anthony Randolph (12.3).
- Rookie guard Stephen Curry is in the top-10 rookie leaders in points (9.2, seventh), assists (5.7, first), field goal percentage (45.8, fourth), three point field goal percentage (45.5, fourth), steals (1.3, fourth) and minutes (31.0, third).
